#### THE CROWNING WITH THORNS

"Then the soldiers of the governor took Jesus into the practorium, and they gathered the whole battalion before him. And they stripped him and put a scarter toole upon him, and platiting a crown of thoras they put it on his head, and put a reed in his right hand. And kneeling before him they mocked him, saying, "Hall, King of the Jewes" (MC 1272-129." It is low to the end! of 1811) that confers on Christ's sacrifice its value as redemption and reparation, as atomement and satisfaction. He knew and loved us all when he offered his life' (CCC, 616).

### THE SCOURGING AT THE PILLAR

"Then Pilate took Jesus and scourged him. And the soldiers platted a crown of thorns, and put it on his head, and arrayed him in a purple robe; they came up to him, saying, 'Hail, King of the Jesus' and struck him with their hands' 'Jesus' sufferings took their historical, concrete form from the fact that he was 'rejected by the elders and the chief priests and the scribes' (MR 831), who 'handed him to the Gentiles to be mocked and scourged and crucified' (Mt 20:19)" (CCC, 572).

# THE CRUCIFIXION

"And when they came to the place which is called The Skull, there they crucified him, and the criminals, one on the right and one on the left. And Jessus said, "Pather, forgive them; for they know not what they do ... It was now about the sixth hour, and there was darkness over the whole land until then hour, while the suns light failed; and the curtain of the temple was torn in two. Then Jesus, crying with a loud voice, said, "Father, into thy hands I commit my spirit!" And having said this hereathed his last" (Iz A 233-46). "Christ died for our sins in accordance with the scriptures' (1 Cor 15:3)" (CCC, 619).

## THE AGONY IN THE GARDEN

"Then Jesus went with them to a place called Gethsemane, and he said to his disciples, Sit here, while I go yonder and pray' And tuking with him Peter and the vo sons of Zebedee, he began to be sorrowful and troubled. Then he said to them, My soul is very sorrowful, even to death; remain here, and watch with me' And going a little farther he fell on his fise and prayed, My Ether, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as you will 'Mt 28:03-293. "Such a battle and auch a victory become possible only through rayer. It is by his prayer that Jesus vanquishes the Tempter, both as the outset of his public mission and in the ultimate struggle of his goom' (CCC, 249).
